1. Playground Update

The playground is now open and there has been some feedback regarding the signage both positive and negative. Initially the park had been very busy but it seemed to have calmed down in recent days. The new matta surface is being installed this week and the verti-draining of the was due also to be done this week.

2. To discuss Signage and agree action

Banners have been placed around the park, as agreed, printed with the Government Guidelines. Some of the banners have been pulled down and damaged and these have since been removed and kept for future use if needed.

Cllr James suggested having more social distancing signs for the cliffs which were discussed along with the problems being faced by wild camping and that the signage that may help discourage this. It was agreed that this would be the responsibility of the National Trust and that a call with the Gower representative asking them to take action may help.

Proposed by JR seconded by CW agreed by all.

Signage for the burial ground was also discussed and it was agreed that this would be arranged between the Clerk and Chair of the Burial Ground Committee.

Cllr Rogers suggested that sporadic gate locking may also help to discourage overnight parking but the signs would need to be put in place first.

3. To discuss potential opening of Community Hall and agree action.

This was briefly discussed and agreed that a covid officer would need to be appointed and that this item be revisited at a later date once the guidelines were a little clearer. It was agreed that the Clerk and Chair would fill in the Claim received from Welsh Government to reclaim lost income for both hall and field.
